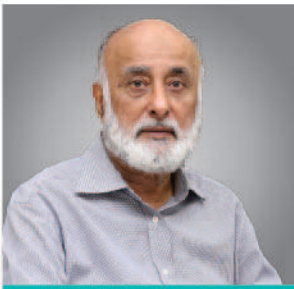


**Prof. Dr. Ejaz Vohra**

My name is Imran Ahmed and I am a resident of Korangi, Karachi. I had an accident while riding motorbike when a car hit me and my leg' bone was broken severely. I was taken to a government hospital and got operated after four days of injury. I got discharged after one month. After a month the doctor took the rod out of my leg but still I was unable to stand and move frequently. Then my family admitted me in a private hospital in Karachi. The treatment continued for a year but it got worse as they installed a short rod in my leg due to which when I started walking, the rod would come out of my leg and I felt severe pain.

Then finally someone suggested me to visit at Chiniot General Hospital and see Dr. Capt. Iqbal Alam. He got my treatment done in three different processes. Firstly, he operated me to take my dead bone out and injected bone cement to let the bone grow. After that, I went under the knife again and the doctor placed a hip bone along with the rod in my leg to get the older shape. It has been a month now and I feel a lot better. I can stand up and walk with considerably less pain. Although medications and follow-ups are continued, I am really hopeful to be able to live a normal life soon. It is all because of the efforts and skills of the doctor and the helpful staff of Chiniot General Hospital.

## Another Star Added to Surgical Department

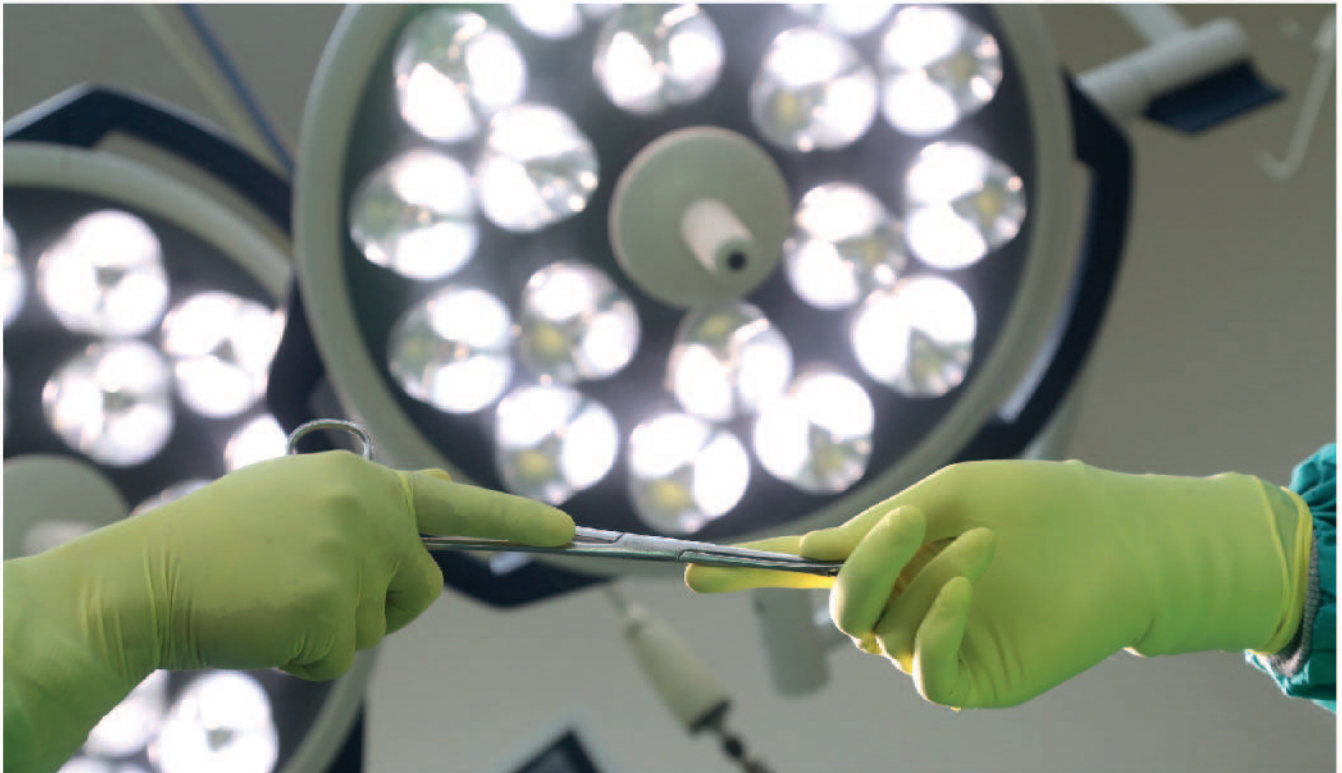

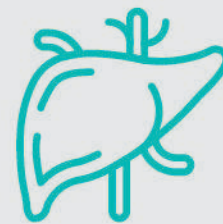
# TB & Hepatitis Treatment

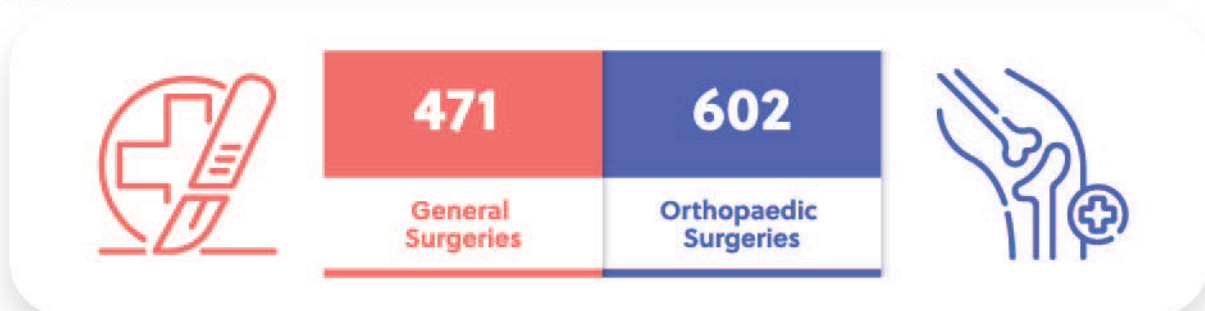


# Department of General Surgery & Orthopaedics

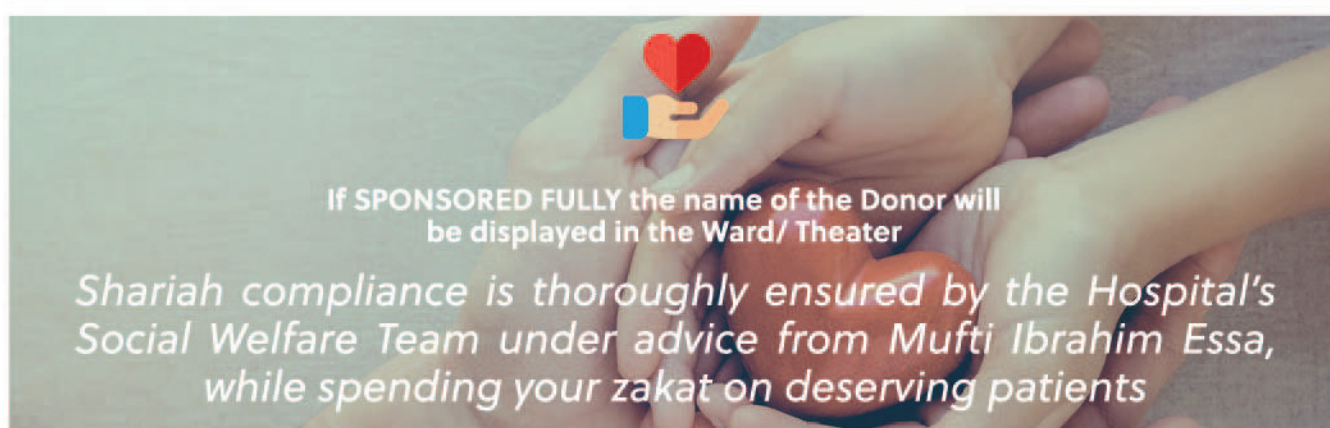
